Class 11—Lucie H for trying her best in all her lessons with fantastic outcomes!

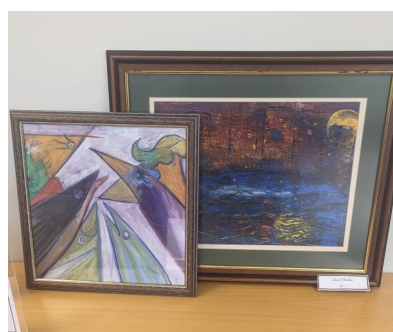
